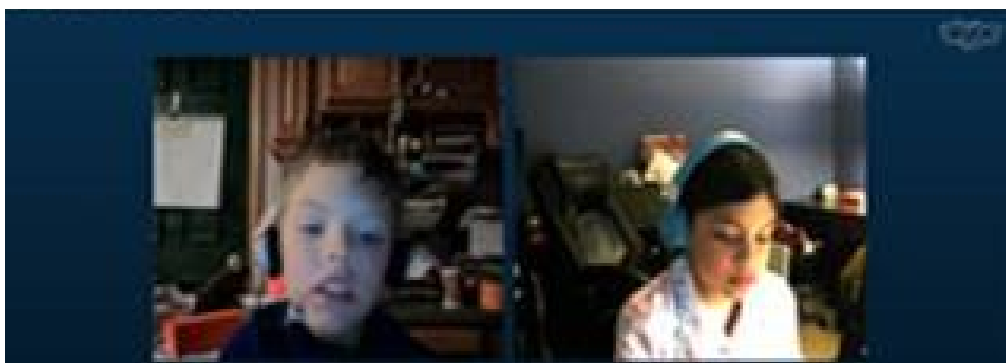


**Does your child need extra help reading pattern words?**
